



## Bradley

This Bardiglio and statuary marble 18th century style chimney piece features a beautifully carved plaque depicting a bear being stung as it steals honey from a hive. This represents Aesop's fable reminding us that it is wiser to bare a single injury in silence than to provoke a thousand by flying into a rage. The delicate shelf and opening mould-ing are crisply carved with egg and dart, while the jambs are carved in statuary with scrolling brackets, acanthus and flower decoration, all applied to the Bardiglio jamb pilasters.
