



## 19th Century Antique

A Baronial style limestone chimneypiece, the frieze with seven stylised heraldic shields, flanked by projecting corner blocks upheld by freestanding figures of Pan and Selene (the Goddess of the Moon), emerging from stylised tapering plinths from the waist. Mid-19th century with later elements. According to Virgil, Pan seduced Selene by offering her a sheepskin, the figure of Pan in this chimneypiece has this held over his shoulder.
